Clothing Guidelines

Style: Formal

Colors: Summery blues, grassy greens, & sunny yellows.

Boys - Dress pants, dress shirt, bow tie, belt, dress shoes.

Girls - Dressy outfit, dress shoes.

*In order to take better photos, please style hair **away from the face**. Also, for ease of playing, please **keep jewelry away from the hands**.*

Getting Ready for the

RECITAL

Hair & Jewelry

Please refrain from jewelry on your child's hands or arms that will interfere with their performance. (Please avoid fussy sleeves also.)

Please make sure your child's hands are clean and nails are neatly trimmed short.

It's best if longer hair is styled back and away from the face, if you want to be able to see your child's face in any photos you take. Otherwise, hair tends to fall forward and cover the face.




What to Bring

The performances will be nearly two hours long. Your child may bring quiet activities to use while they are waiting.

Electronic devices are permitted, as long as they are used on silent or with headphones.

If your child brings personal items, please store them in a bag or backpack and make sure all items have your child's name on them.

Please note: We cannot be responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.



Food & Snacks

We will be providing water and pizza during both performances.

***If you want to send additional snacks with your child, please make sure they are easy to eat and are not sticky. Also please remind your child not to share snacks in case of food allergies.*



Tuning

If your child is playing any instrument other than the piano, please make sure to correctly tune the instrument before you leave home. This will help Ms. Enny get all the instruments ready quickly before the recital.

ARRIVING FOR PERFORMANCE 1

Students will need to be accompanied to the Rehearsal Room by an adult (with a ticket) before 1:40.

If your child is bringing an instrument, please arrive at 1:30 promptly.

After entering the theater, please stop by the restroom first, if needed, then go through the ticketing line. (Your student won't need a ticket.) Follow the signs to the Rehearsal Room.

*****We will not be using the back entrance.***

The Rehearsal Room will be busy at this time, so please make your way to the auditorium once you've dropped your child off.

Please remember to bring your cello stand, the cello stopper, your tuner, and your rosin.


GUITARS
